- **Music:**
 - Changing the Music:
 - Each Animoto style automatically comes with its own paired music. However, if you would like to change the song, click on the musical note icon in the left-hand corner and the music libraries will appear.
 - Adding Music:
 - If you would like to substitute your own music, click on the musical note icon in the left-hand corner, choose “Upload Songs,” and select the music file from your computer.
 - Adjusting the length of your music:
 - Click on the gear icon in the upper right-hand corner.
 - Under “Song Trim,” click on the slider to make the music clip as long as you would like it. When you are satisfied with the length, click “Save.”
- **Speed:**
 - Adjusting the speed of your video:
 - Click on the gear icon in the upper right-hand corner.
 - Under “Image Pacing,” click on the slider to make it faster or slower. When you are satisfied with the speed, click “Save.”
 - If you want to add more photos, make your video pacing faster.
 - If you want to make the pace of your video slower, in addition to manually changing the pace of the video, you can also choose a slower song.
- **Photos:**
 - Make a photo more prominent:
 - Click on the photo, click on the “Spotlight” icon on the left-hand side, and a yellow frame will now appear around your photo.
 - To caption a photo:
 - Click on the photo, click “Caption,” type your caption, and click “Save.”
- **Videos:**
 - Adjusting the sound on a video clip:
 - Double-click on the video clip and click on the audio icon to mute it. To restore the audio, click on the icon again.
 - Adjusting the length of a video clip:
 - Double-click on the video clip, click on the slide bar to adjust the length, and click “Save.”

- **To edit an existing Animoto:**
 - Under your username, click “My Videos.”
 - Click on the gear icon under the Animoto video you want to edit.
 - Click “Edit a Copy”
 - Make the changes you want and click “Save.”
- **To loop an Animoto video on your website:**
 - When your Animoto video is completed and produced, under “Share” click “More.”
 - Click the “Embedded Video” tab.
 - Click “Loop,” copy the HTML code to a clipboard, and embed it onto your website.
- **FAQ:**
 - How long does my Educator account last?
 - Your account will automatically expire after six months. You can re-apply for a new account when your old one expires.
 - Can other people see my students’ videos or contact my students through Animoto?
 - From Animoto technical services, *“Absolutely not. All videos are completely private. The only way someone can watch a video is if they are directed to that video's specific URL, or if that video is posted to another website.
